MINUTES

Call to Order: Meeting called to order by Chairman Nordmeyer at 5:13 pm.

Approve Minutes of June 11, 2018 – Maynard/Connelly motion to approve. Motion carried 3 to 0.

Discussion, Consideration and Recommendation on the following:

Fire & Rescue Department

Monthly Report – Rescue Squad had 23 calls in the Village, 6 Township and 2 MABIS. Fire Department had 7 calls in the Village, 2 Township and 3 MABIS.

Reclassification of Rescue Squad

Dr. McNeal will be attending tonight’s Village Board meeting to explain this further. Rescue Chief Kelly stated they are starting to get assistance from other departments as well as Associate Membership.

Police Department

Court Update – Forfeitures of \$15,414.70 were collected in June.

Monthly Report – The Police Department responded to 533 calls.

Adding a 4-way stop sign to Bennett Drive and Williams Street

President Connelly stated this intersection is in his neighborhood. His neighbors asked to have a 4 way stop due to concerns with the high rate of speed. There are no sidewalks and a lot of kids use the streets. Chief Hammett doesn’t see a reason why we cannot add 4 way stop signs. It will help slow traffic.

Connelly/Maynard motion to recommend adding a 4-way stop sign to Bennett Drive and Williams Street. Motion carried 3 to 0.

Gas card for Village Gas and Grocery and BP Gas and Grocery

Mr. Singh approached President Connelly about obtaining a BP gas card. Mr. Connelly feels the police presence would be good as there are a lot of drive offs at these gas stations. Chief Hammett spoke with a prior Police Chief who stated when they explored it last Citgo was unable to take off the fuel tax. Mr. Connelly had brought this up to Mr. Singh who advised they have the same program as Mobil. Trustee Nordmeyer suggested a Wright Express card that can be used at any gas station. The Committee instructed the clerk to research the issue and provide information to the Finance Committee.

Connelly/Maynard motion to refer to Finance Committee. Motion carried 3 to 0.

Chief Hammett has reviewed and approved all applications.
