MINUTES

Call to Order: Meeting called to order by Chairman Nordmeyer at 5:30 pm.

Present: Trustee Nordmeyer, Maynard, President Connelly. Also Present: Lt. Milligan, Deputy Chief Kelley, Clerk Treasurer Waswo, and Trustee Czaja

Comments from the Public – None.

Approve Minutes of August 6, 2018 – Maynard/Connelly motion to approve. Motion carried 3 to 0.

Discussion, Consideration and Recommendation on the following:

Fire & Rescue Department

Monthly Report – Rescue had 10 calls with 217 year to date. Fire had 6 calls with 74 year to date. Deputy Chief Kelley reported Metro employee Cory Schultz was hired as paid on premise. They have another interview tomorrow to replace Metro employee Kathy Smith who is still on the department as a volunteer. Kathy Springhorn was placed on the department roster as an EMT. Currently Walworth Fire Rescue has 26 members and 5 associates members (all EMTs): 20 firefighters, 10 EMTs, and 6 EMRs. One member is starting EMT class next week. Kathy Smith is also an A. We are waiting on the Town Board letter of understanding for the downgrade to basic level squad.

Stipend pay will be changing to \$25 during the week. Currently it's \$15 during the week and \$25 on the weekend. The Fire department will pay the difference out of their funds until the end of the year and will add it to the budget for next year, around \$3,300.

Police Department

Court Update – Forfeitures of \$15,067.16 were collected in August.

Monthly Report – The Police Department responded to 539 calls. Those calls may go down as the state is looking at ending the grant program. It is time to get a new squad. Lt. Milligan is obtaining quotes from Kunes and Ewald. The department would like to keep the old squad instead of trading it in. Trade in value is between \$10,000 to \$12,000. Currently we are a taxi back and forth for the School Resource Officer. This squad would allow more freedom for the SRO, as well as go to court instead of taking someone off the road. The additional squad will also be a backup squad in case one of the others is down.
